Age Range: 4+

Materials: colored pencils, crayons, paint, or pencil; paper or the <u>Design Your Own Coin worksheet</u> (PDF)

Did you know that the Mint makes coins with different designs? For example, as part of the <u>America the</u> <u>Beautiful Quarters® Program</u>, the Mint makes quarters with different designs of national parks and other national sites for each of the 50 states and U.S. territories.

Brainstorm ideas for what you would want to see on a coin and then draw, sketch, or paint your design using your own paper or the <u>Design Your Own Coin</u> worksheet (PDF).
